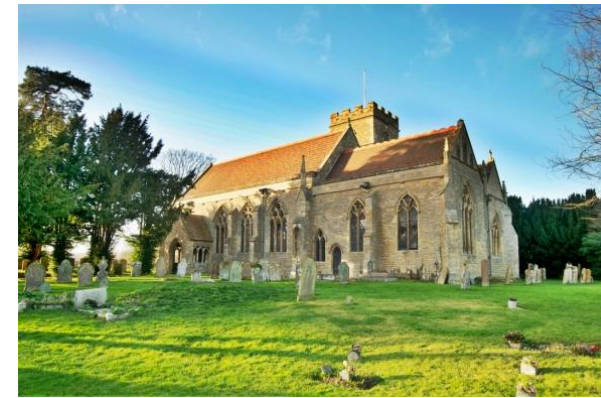
### **Our mission: Releasing growth through:**

**Welcome!** We're delighted you came today. Here's a bit more about what goes on here.

We're a happy and growing community, with people of all ages represented, from 0 to 90. We meet every Sunday at **11.15am**, and each of our services is slightly different:

**1<sup>st</sup> Sunday** Family Communion and Children's Church

**2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday** All Age Worship – shorter, noisier, we all stay together

**3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday** Family Communion and Children's Church

**4<sup>th</sup> Sunday** 'Go4th', starts 9.30am for breakfast, followed by worship at 10.15 and community projects at 10.45. An exciting way to serve our community 😊 and sometimes there's a fifth Sunday in the month! We also offer a traditional communion at 8.30am on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month.

We love children being involved here. Our fortnightly Children's Church is great for 4-11 year olds. For younger ones, we have books and toys available at the back to use at any time, and bags of activities to use in the pews. A bit of noise is always fine, too!

There's lots happening during the week, too, such as our weekly study group, fortnightly youth group (Rock Solid), monthly Friday coffee morning, monthly evening Communion service, bell-ringing practice, craft group, and prayer group.

We are committed to serving our community in other ways too – for example via donations to the Food Bank and MK Storehouse.
